



Then we raked it to make the soil smooth.






After that we planted the vegetables. We made a small hole in the soil with a trowel.


We put the roots of the plant in the hole and pushed soil around them.

We planted some tomatoes.










Then we sowed some coriander seeds.





We cut some plastic bottles.


We put them over some of the plants to protect them from the wind, rain, slugs and snails.
